SCOPE OF SERVICES

- **Cancer Screening** Our aim is to detect cancer in its early asymptomatic phase. Early cancer is curable in majority of cases. We offer screening for breast, colorectal, lung, prostate, head and neck, for familial cancers, cervical cancers and other cancers
- Early detection of multi cancer using genetic solutions– screening for cancers of the color, lung, breast, liver, stomach
- We use advanced technology to detect circulating tumour DNA from the tumour cells in the blood. We utilise next generation sequencing and utilise machine learning models and convolutional neural network to detect origin of tumour. These tests are NON INVASIVE
- Detect circulating tumour cells in the blood using Immunocytochemistry
- Genetic counselling, consultation with our senior clinical oncologists at Continental Hospitals (CHL)
- "CHL" early cancer screening blood test is a thorough check for the existence of cancer in your body, identity which type of cancer you have and the organ of the cancer from which organ using liquid biopsy





- Full blood profile estimation, tumour markers, protein biomarkers, antitumour antibodies hormone analysis for hormone secreting tumours, patterns of DNA methylation, measuring changes in DNA and RNA Stool tests to detect blood in stools (Faecal immunochemical test)
- Urine Cytology
- Low dose high resolution CT Scan for early lung cancer
- Mammography, Multe parametric MRI, for breast cancer
- Multi parametric MRI for prostate cancer
- Whole body MRI, CT, PET Scan
- CT Colonography, Colonoscopy, Upper GI Endoscopy
- Ultrasonography
